

1. **Clews platter**  
Early 19th century Clews Staffordshire, oriental blue & white decorated platter,  
18 ½ x 15 ¾ inches.
2. **Minton's tiles**  
Four framed antique Minton's tiles, Four Seasons,  
6 x 6 inches.
3. **Roseville teapots**  
Two Roseville pottery Clematis teapots,  
both 7 x 11 x 8 inches.
4. **Royal Doulton jugs**  
Five Royal Doulton character jugs, including Robin Hood, Barleycorn Old Lad, Old King Cole, etc.,  
all approximately 3 inches tall.
5. **J & G Alcock platter**  
Circa 1839 to 1846 J & G Alcock "Pompeii" pattern platter,  
15 ½ x 12 inches.
6. **Torquay motto ware**  
Four pieces of Torquay pottery motto ware, "Time and Tide Wait for No Man" etc.,  
4 ½ to 6 inches tall.
7. **Pair of Satsuma vases**  
Satsuma bulbous vases having floral and gilded decorations on wood stands,  
minor chips, 10 inches tall.
8. **Minton's tiles**  
Seven Minton's circa 1870s tiles "Idylls of a King" designed by John Moyr Smith,  
6 x 6 inches.
9. **Brown, Westhead, Moore & Co.**  
19th C. Brown, Westhead, Moore & Co. "Indian Empress" blue/white decorated  
platter,  
large size, 22 x 17 inches.
10. **Royal Crown Derby**  
Eleven Royal Crown Derby "Mikado" cups & saucers.
11. **Pewter tankards**  
Five antique pewter tankards, including William Hux London 1784-1850 quart,  
W. Phillips 1820, Samuel Cox, London 1820 etc.

**12. Poole Canada goose**

Poole pottery Canada Goose by Barbara Linley-Adams numbered 284/500  
produced 1973-1978,  
9 ½ x 17 x 9 ½ inches.

**13. Cherub tile artwork**

Circa 1870 pencil sketch of a Cherub, purportedly artwork for a tile,  
5 ¾ x 5 ¾ inches.

**14. Limoges “Paradise” dinner set**

Theodore Haviland, Limoges “Paradise” dinner and tea set,  
approximately 70 pieces.

**15. Roseville pottery vases**

Two Roseville pottery, Freesia pottery vases,  
6 ¼ and 7 ¼ inches tall.

**16. Royal Doulton**

Royal Doulton figure “Tootles” HN 1680, Cat, Shakespearean Knights mug and a  
Goosey Goosey Gander mug.

**17. Flow blue platter**

Antique ironstone flow blue platter,  
17 1/2 x 14 inches.

**18. Minton’s tiles**

Five Victorian Minton’s Shakespearean tiles,  
6 x 6 inches together with stands.

**19. Two tiles**

Framed Minton’s Oxford Cathedral tile together with a vintage H&R Johnson  
Canterbury Pilgrims tile 6 x 6 inches.

**20. Japanese eggshell porcelain**

Vintage Japanese eggshell porcelain tea & dessert set including teapot,  
cream & sugar, 11 cups and saucers,  
eleven 7 inch plates and two 8 ½ inch plates.

**21. Torquay Motto ware**

Six pieces of antique Torquay pottery motto ware including “One Today is Worth Two  
Tomorrow’s”, candlesticks, etc.,  
tallest 5 inches.

**22. Two antique platters**

Two antique platters, Coalport “Pastoral” 15 x 12 inches and “Wild Rose” pattern  
circa 1830, 16 ½ x 12 ½ inches  
(both stained)

**23. Belleek China**

Belleek Shamrock biscuit jar and vase, two "New Shell" cups & saucers and two plates 6 inches diameter.

**24. Antique ceramic calendar**

Wedgewood tile calendar, New Building of Jones, McDuffee and Stratton Boston 1906.

4  $\frac{3}{4}$  x 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches.

**25. Royal Doulton character jugs**

Five Royal Doulton character jugs, including three John Peel, Fatboy and the Cardinal,

2 inches tall.

**26. Roseville pottery vase and pocket**

Roseville pottery vase, Snowberry pattern 7  $\frac{1}{4}$  inches tall and a Gardenia wall pocket 8  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches long.

**27. Early pitchers**

Five antique jugs including flight Worcester circa 1790, 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches tall, early Imari pattern 3 inches tall, Parian jug, etc.

(Chinoiserie cracked)

**28. Minton's tiles**

Six Victorian Minton's tiles, including early English History series, King Canute, Edy & Elgiva etc.

6 x 6 inches.

**29. Canadian historical platter**

Wallis Grimson and Company potteries, Staffordshire circa 1884 Canadian historical scenes,

15  $\frac{1}{4}$  x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches (staining)

**30. Pair of Satsuma moriage vases**

Pair of early 20th century Japanese Satsuma moriage enamel decorated vases, 16 inches tall.

**31. Early 19th century pewter**

Five pewter tankards including John Abbot 1812-1863, Richard Yates 1772-1832, etc.

**32. Hope & Carter platter**

Victorian Hope & Carter "Chinese pattern" platter,

18 x 14 inches.

**33. Royal Worcester tea set**

Royal Worcester, Willow pattern, tea set, teapot, cream & sugar bowl, five cups & saucers and five 6inch plates.

**34. Cranberry decanter and glasses**

Sixteen cranberry stemmed glasses together with a decanter 10 inches tall.

**35. Silver plate**

Antique silver plated cocktail shaker and cruet set with four crystal bottles. (some chips), 9 x 6 1/2 x 6 1/2 inches

**36. Josef Kuba plates**

Six Josef Kuba (JKW) Bavaria porcelain lobster pattern dinner plate plates, 10 inches diameter.

**37. Antique tiles**

Four antique tiles, including Minton, 6 x 6 inches (chips)

**38. American Majolica**

Five pieces including a Etrusian Majolica serving plate 10 x 12 inches and four Majolica plates.

**39. Roseville pottery**

Roseville pottery Clematis pattern candlestick 5 inches tall together with an Iris blue vase 4 inches tall.

**40. Shaving mugs**

Nine antique shaving mugs including Old Foley together with two shaving brushes.

**41. Vienna porcelain**

Austrian Vienna "Alhambra" porcelain, including cups and saucers, serving plates, etc., 15 pieces

**42. Antique platter**

Victorian Podmore Walker & Co. "Amerillia " Well and Tree platter, 20 x 16 inches (staining)

**43. Minton's tiles**

Four 19th century Minton's tiles, 6 x 6 inches.

**44. Cranberry glass**

Ten pieces of cranberry glass, including jugs, covered bowl, glasses, and a vase 7 1/2 inches tall (chips to lid and one glass).

**45. Six porcelain bowls**

Six porcelain bowls, including Birks, made in France, Schumann, Noritaki, largest 10 ½ x 3 inches.

**46. Victorian platter and bowls**

Victorian Clementson Brothers, Springtime ivory ware platter 18 x 14 inches (small crack & stained) together with two rimmed soup bowls.

**47. Cups & saucers**

Six George Jones Crescent China demitasse coffee cups & saucers together with three R.S Germany cups & saucers.

**48. Crystal vase and glasses**

Cut crystal pinwheel vase 9 ½ tall x 9 inches diameter, contemporary crystal bowl 5 ½ x 8 inches diameter together with six wine glasses.

**49. Copeland Spode platter**

Antique Copeland late Spode "Eden" serving platter, 17 x 13 inches.

**50. Torquay Motto ware**

Five Torquay Motto ware cups & saucers with a jug 5 inches tall "Be Like the Sundial Count only Sunny Hours"

**51. New Wharf part dinner set**

Victorian New Wharf "Sterling" part dinner set, 50 pieces (some staining).

**52. Early pewter plates**

Six early English pewter plates including John Jackson 1689 - 1731, Henry Sewdley 1706-1738, Giffen 1770-1778, 8 to 9 inches diameter.

**53. Pewter tankards**

Four antique English/Scottish pewter mugs, J Moyes Edinburgh, 1870, pre-imperial Durham circa 1800, etc.

**54. Four gallon crock**

Antique four gallon open crock.

**55. Woodland platter**

Wood & Sons Bursley "Woodland" platter, 16 x 13 inches.

**56. Minton's "Grasmere" tea set**

Minton Grasmere teaset, teapot, cream & sugar, two cups & saucers.

**57. RS Germany collection**

Collection of RS Germany porcelain, teapot, cream and sugars, plates, etc.

**58. Beswick and Goebel etc.**

Beswick Beneagles scotch figure, Beswick Sheep and Duck (both repaired),  
Goebel porcelain rocking horse money box, etc.

**59. Antique coloured glasses**

Twenty six antique coloured glasses.

**60. Early Mason's and Spode plates**

Pair of Spode's new tone plates circa 1825 9 ½ inches diameter,  
Mason's ironstone plate 9 ½ inches diameter circa 1820 and a Mason's plate  
1813-1825 9 ½ inches diameter.

**61. Antique platters**

Two antique platters, Charles Meigh & Son "Jenny Lind" 1850s, 12 x 9 ½ inches  
and Etruscan Vases transfer platter 14 x 11 inches (small chip).

**62. Nodding figures**

Six antique German porcelain nodding figures,  
tallest 5 ½ inches  
(chips to hat).

**63. Blue/white platter and plates**

Antique Coudon platter 12 ½ x 10 ½ inches together with two antique flow blue  
plates 9 ½ inches.

**64. French porcelain**

Possibly Sevres circa 1849 to 1856 porcelain serving dishes, classical figure and  
Greek key designs, pedestal bowl 10 x 3 ½ inches.  
(some wear)

**65. Chamber pot and water container**

Victorian Melrose pattern lidded chamber pot  
together with a large water container 16 x 15 x 9 ½ inches  
(some wear).

**66. R.S & R bowl and a Mason's tureen**

Antique Ridgway, Sparks and Ridgway "Indus" bowl 10 ½ inches diameter together  
with a Mason's "Ascot" sauce tureen, 5 ½ tall x 9 x 6 inches.

**67. Porcelain figural groups**

Two antique porcelain figural groups, Mother & Children having gilt highlights,  
9 x 10 x 7 and a Capodimonte blanc de chine classical figure 10 x 16 x 6 inches  
(chips to flowers)

**68. Royal Worcester, etc.**

Royal Worcester jug 5 ½ inches tall, early possibly Ridgway's plate 7 ¾ x 6 ½ inches, and an antique cup & saucer.

**69. Italian Majolica jar**

Old Italian Majolica handled jar "SV Di Ribes"  
9 x 9 x 7 ½ inches.

**70. Porcelain centrepiece**

Portuguese porcelain pedestal fruit basket centrepiece having gilt highlights to the white glaze,  
9 ½ x 9 ½ inches diameter.

**71. Chinese tree**

Vintage Chinese decorative cork tree, plaster base with a blanc de chine Guanyin figure,  
15 tall x 14 x 7 inches.

**72. Chinese figures**

Pair of Chinese blue glazed figures 8 inches tall together with five Chinese blanc de chine figures,  
tallest 10 inches (chips to smaller figures).

**73. Pewter mugs and measures**

Six antique 18th/19th century mugs and measures including half pint, gill and pre-imperial.

**74. Blue & white plates**

Four blue/white decorated plates, including Royal Crown Derby "Mikado", Royal Doulton etc.  
(8-10 ½ inches).

**75. Studio glass, etc.**

Pair of studio glass candlesticks signed S. Bisley 7 ¼ inches tall, two paperweights one signed Carol Nesbitt and four Czech crystal salt & peppers.

**76. Torquay pottery**

Two Torquay pottery jugs 4 ½ inches tall with three pieces of motto ware (small chips).

**77. Pottery serving dishes**

Two studio pottery, serving dishes,  
13 ½ x 2 ½ and 12 ½ x 1 ½ inches deep.

**78. Antique plates**

Antique T. Hughes "Sitka" platter 11 ½ x 9 inches, two Copeland late Spode "Bridal Veil" plates 10 ½ inches diameter, Grindley "Daffodil" plate 10 ½ inches and a Ludlow Castle plate.

**79. Placemats, plates, etc.**

Set of six English cottages placemats 8 ½ x 7 ½ inches , Chinese bowl & cup, Bunnykins bowl and plates.

**80. Porcelain figures, etc.**

Mexican porcelain nodding figure salt & pepper stand, Toby jug, Yardley English Lavender figure 7 ½ inches tall and a composite figure, etc.

**81. Miscellaneous dinnerware**

Miscellaneous antique dinnerware, including Alfred Meechan "Devon", New Warfe Hampden, etc. (stains and chips) approximately 60 pieces.

**82. Kutani and Satsuma**

Japanese Satsuma Moriage vase 12 inches tall together with a Kutani pitcher, 7 inches tall.

**83. Beswick dog and Wedgwood**

Beswick dog, Goebel bird and three pieces of Wedgwood Jasperware.

**84. Antique pewter**

Antique pewter mugs, measures, early fake measure, etc.

**85. Antique Metalware**

Antique pewter tray by Isaac Whitehorse 1820s, Reed & Barton copper measures, trivet, etc.

**86. Glasses and mugs**

Sixteen tall flutes, three martini glasses, four AY Jackson design mugs, plates and shot glasses.

**87. Fourteen reference books.**

Fourteen reference books incl. Clocks & Pewter, etc.

**88. Eleven reference books**

Eleven antiques reference books, American antiques, etc.

**89. Maker's marks & Britten's clocks**

Four reference books, including Britten's clocks, Silver and Gold marks and Pottery and Porcelain marks.

**90. Twelve books Canada**

Twelve books Canada, incl. Pierre Berton My Country and The Wild Frontier, Present Faces of Waterloo Past, Etc.

**91. Worthies of England, 1811**

Two volumes Worthies of England, 1811 by Thomas Fuller DD.

**92. Canadian antiques and art**

Five volumes Canadian silver, Upper Canadian furniture, Canadian painting, etc.

**93. Spanish Conquest in America**

Four volumes Spanish Conquest in America, Arthur Phelps 1855.

**94. Reference books**

Eight reference books, including the Inuit print, English Barometers, Nautical antiques, etc.

**95. Six reference books**
